

On July 26, 2021, "Amami-Oshima Island, Tokunoshima Island, Northern Part of Okinawa Island, and Iriomote Island" were registered as a Natural World Heritage Site. The land area of the four Ryukyu Islands, located at



the southern end of the Japanese archipelago, has been registered as a Natural World Heritage Site. Although the area of the Natural World

Heritage Site is 42,698ha, less than 0.5% of Japan, there are 95 globally threatened species and 75 of them are endemic to these areas. It is a region with outstanding biodiversity even in Japan, one of the world's biodiversity hotspots.

The center also serves as a base for conservation and management, promoting the proper use of Amamigunto National Park and measures against poaching.

Exhibition Room

This room recreates the forests of Amami-Oshima, letting you experience change over the course of the day through the cries of animals, the sound of rain, and changes in brightness. Here, you can also enjoy different video and audio with each season.
